Item	Cost	Objective	Outcome/Impact
Netball court markings on the playground.	£475	To enable school to establish a netball team.	Since the netball court markings have been made, a High 5 netball after-school club has been established which has increased the uptake of after-school sports within school.
Zumba after-school club provision.	£700	To respond to feedback from parent questionnaires for dance to be included as an after-school provision.	The after-school club was very popular across the whole school and many of the children were attending a club for the first time. Teachers had the opportunity to observe the club as part of their CPD.
Rugby (professional coaching).	£1393	To provide Rugby coaching to KS2 for part of the year and to provide them with opportunities to develop motor skills, along with teamwork, respect and fair play.	All KS2 teachers have had the opportunity to work with the coaches to develop skills in teaching rugby. All KS2 children have developed their skills within the game and have had the chance to be competitive during inter-school games.
Football - Stockport County Football Club (professional coaching).	£800	To provide professional football coaching for KS1 children and to work with teachers as part of their continuing professional development. To establish links with local sports clubs.	All KS1 children have had the opportunity to work with the coaches to develop their motor skills. Children have learnt to work as part of a team. Children had the opportunity to be competitive throughout the lessons and during a tournament organised by the club. Children have been offered free tickets to watch Stockport County play at their local stadium, thereby establishing links with the local area.
Sports Day	£54.60	To provide specific equipment, including stickers and medals in order to establish a regular School Sports Day.	All children have had the opportunity to compete at school sports day and to win medals and stickers.
Replacing and purchasing new sports equipment.	£879.80	To audit sports equipment and replace / purchase any equipment needed.	Sports equipment for the school is now in good condition for the coming years, with the addition of new equipment to enable us to provide new clubs and activities for the children.
