

Prime Learning Challenge: Is Greece full of amazing gods and brave warriors?

Breadth of Study:

History. Plot history on a timeline using centuries. Place periods of history on a timeline showing periods of time. Use mathematical skills to round up time differences into centuries and decades. Explain how events from Ancient Greece have helped shape our lives today e.g. democracy /Olympic games. Recognise how items found belonging to the past are helping us to build an accurate picture of how people lived in the past. Research Greek Gods.

Art: DT. Draw Greek patterned pots and make an Olympic torch using given materials.

Literacy. Historical fiction / Fables and Greek Myths / explanation texts.

Geography Research. A city study. Use maps, atlases, globes and digital mapping to locate places and describe features studied. Describe main physical differences between cities and villages.

IT: Internet research, green screen technology, iMovie video editing software.
