Primary PE Passport	£400	To provide an online and easy assessment and planning tool for teachers to use to ensure progression throughout the year groups.	Training has now been given and all classes are now loaded onto the system. The app will be used by all teachers in the Summer 2 term with the aim of being established and giving a baseline for the next academic year.
Stockport Harriers Cross Country League.	£50	Entry for KS2 children to join the Cross Country League with the objective of increasing competition throughout the school.	The event was well attended and gave children the opportunity to compete against other schools. The children have promoted the event at school and it is hoped that more children will participate next year.
Curriculum and after-school Football - Stockport County Football Club (professional coaching). Including new motor skills after school club for Reception/Year 1.	£3920	To provide professional football coaching for KS1 and KS2 children, including an after-school club to increase competitiveness in KS2 children. Also, to teach motor skills to children in reception. Furthermore, to work with teachers as part of their continuing professional development. To establish links with local sports clubs.	All Reception, KS1 and KS2 children have had the opportunity to work with the coaches to develop their motor skills. Children have learnt to work as part of a team, the importance of which was further outlined in a special assembly for the children where a member of the First team spoke to them about healthy lifestyles. Children have been offered free tickets to watch Stockport County play at their local stadium, thereby establishing links with the local community. The teachers have worked closely with the coaches to ensure that they are able to sustain the high level of coaching once the funding ends. KS1 and Reception now have the opportunity to take part in healthy after-school activities.
Gymnastics coaching	£1819	To provide specialised coaching of gymnastics, along with training and lesson plans to ensure that the learning is sustainable in years to come.	Teachers have had the opportunity to work with the coaches to support them in their teaching of gymnastics which has been valuable. We now have a bank of resources to use in the future. Children have had good quality teaching of gymnastics.
Physical Development Equipment	£254.90	To provide equipment to support the teaching of PE throughout the school.	More children got the opportunity to take part in the competition because of this and helped us get closer to achieving the Sports Mark.
