Full Opening of School: September 2020

Following the announcement by the Government at the beginning of July, we have been busy updating our risk assessments to ensure that school can reopen safely for all children and staff.

We will be continuing to be proactive with Prevention Controls:

1. Minimise contact with individuals who are unwell by ensuring that those who have coronavirus (COVID-19) symptoms, or who have somebody in their household who does, do not attend school.
2. Clean hands thoroughly more often than usual.
3. Ensure good respiratory hygiene by promoting the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach.
4. Continuing with enhanced cleaning, including frequently touched surfaces throughout the day.
5. Minimise contact between individuals and **maintain social distancing wherever possible**.
6. Where necessary, wear appropriate PPE.

This means that children will be in 'Year Group Bubbles' and will be kept apart from other groups wherever possible. Therefore, each Year Group will have its own start and finish times, as well as separate break and lunchtimes. To assist us in the smooth implementation of these measures, please ensure you know the start and finish times for your child's bubble.
