Curriculum and after-school coaches (football/multi-skills).	£2660	To provide professional football coaching for KS1 and KS2 children, including an after-school club to increase competitiveness in KS2 children. Also, to teach motor skills to children in reception. Furthermore, to work with teachers as part of their continuing professional development. To establish links with local sports clubs.	All Reception, KS1 and KS2 children have had the opportunity to work with the coaches to develop their motor skills. Children have learnt to work as part of a team, the importance of which was further outlined in a special assembly for the children where a member of the First team spoke to them about healthy lifestyles. Children have been offered free tickets to watch Stockport County play at their local stadium, thereby establishing links with the local community. The teachers have worked closely with the coaches to ensure that they are able to sustain the high level of coaching once the funding ends. KS1 and Reception now have the opportunity to take part in healthy after-school activities.
Membership to Stockport SHAPES Alliance	£2300	To increase the number of competitive events that our children can compete in and to have access to professional development for teachers.	Membership to the SHAPES Alliance has meant that our children have been able to attend a number of after-school competitions which has helped to improve their enjoyment for sport as well as their competitiveness. The PE Lead has attended a number of training courses provided by the alliance and has disseminated this information in staff meetings. It has also opened up a huge network of support.

Stockport Harriers Cross Country	£56	To Entry for KS2 children to join the Cross Country League with the objective of increasing competition throughout the school	The event was well attended and gave children the opportunity to compete against other schools.
Gymnastic Coaching	£770	To provide specialised coaching of gymnastics, along with training and lesson plans to ensure that the learning is sustainable in years to come.	Teachers have had the opportunity to work with the coaches to support them in their teaching of gymnastics which has been valuable. We now have a bank of resources to use in the future. Children have had good quality teaching of gymnastics
Sportsafe UK Limited	£1632.72	Repairs and Safety checks	Annual safety check and repair to a number of condemned apparatus on the trim trail. This has allowed us to reopen the climbing wall and the trim trail equipment so that children can improve their physical development when using the outdoor area.
Staffing Costs	£38.55	Payment for Teaching Assistants to attend after-school competitive events.	This has enabled the after-school competitions to take place as it has meant we had the required ratios to attend competitions.
Transport Costs	£639.85	Coaches and Minibus hire to take children to events.	This money has allowed us to attend a wider range of competitions and for our children to experience competitions across a wider range of schools.
PE Equipment	£49.99	Purchase of new sports equipment	Replacing old and damaged equipment has allowed us to continue to have high quality resources available to support PE Lessons.
