Religious Education at Our Lady's Catholic Primary School is not confined to a specific timetabled lesson, but is encompassed within all of our teaching. Here, the spiritual, moral, social and cultural development of each child is addressed through all aspects of the curriculum as well as through the various day-to-day situations and opportunities that arise. Formal RE is delivered through the scheme **The Way The Truth and The Life**, which is followed according to the Shrewsbury Diocesan guidelines.

The Way the Truth and the Life scheme is implemented from Reception Class through to Year 6. Each year is split into 6 topics, one per half term and is organised to coincide with major events in the liturgical year. Each year group studies a different topic.
