Outdoor physical skills event for Year 6, including transport.	£1017	To provide an outdoor activities experience for Year 6 as part of the PE curriculum.	Children were involved in team building activities and worked together, building confidence in activities such as orienteering and navigating equipment and apparatus safely.
Tennis Coaching for KS2, including CPD	£412.50	To provide alternative sports sessions to KS2 classes and add to teacher's CPD in order for them to deliver lessons in school.	Children in KS2 have enjoyed the tennis coaching and have all begun to learn a new skill. It has improved their coordination and built their fitness. Staff have learnt skills to help them deliver tennis lessons in school.
Stockport County	£3880	To deliver motor skills / football to all year groups. Deliver CPD to staff in a range of sports and provide lunch and after school clubs.	Staff have been able to learn a range of skills in improving children's motor skills, and a range of sports, including Dodgeball. Children have taken part in engaging and energetic lessons and have had the opportunity to improve their fitness by taking part in sports at lunchtime and after school.
New and replacement sport equipment.	£1262.88	To update stock of PE equipment to include new sports such as Dodgeball. To replace damaged/worn equipment.	School now has a good range of resources and equipment to support children with their physical activities.
Sportsafe UK	£176.38	Inspection of all PE equipment to ensure Health and Safety compliance.	All equipment inspected and declared safe.
Thermapply	£4850	Playground markings for the whole playground to encourage physical activity at playtimes and lunchtimes.	Children now have a range of sports and activities which they can take part in a break and lunch time. This has led to an improvement in the amount of physical activity taking place.

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Cross Country	£554.63	Entry to Cross Country League and purchase of new printed running vests for the growing number of participants.	Our school now has branded running vests in line with other schools at the competition. This has led to an increase in participation from the children as they enjoy feeling part of a team. We had a number of children in the top ten for individual races and the Year 3-4 boys team won a trophy.
Standing Desks	£633.20	Participation in the Standing Desk scheme to encourage physical development of targeted children and support children who do/can not sit at their desk.	The desks have been a success for those identified children, enabling them to remain standing when working.
Stockport Shapes Alliance	£2600	Enrolment in the Stockport Shapes Alliance to gain access to Stockport-wide CPD and competitions.	This has enabled staff to be kept up to date with PE developments. The subject leader has attended their CPD meetings and disseminated information to staff. Children have had access to competitions.
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
